Ms. Chalanouli is a European Council of Bars and Law Societies of Europe (CCBE) accredited lawyer, member of the Bar Associations of Athens (appointed before the Supreme Court) and Madrid and a Data Protection Officer. Currently teaching at the Universidad Catolica de Murcia (UCAM), she has lectured in the IIHL in Sanremo, NATO (School and MIOTC), the JAG Army School.

She has previously served as a deputy Appeals Board member for the EU Satellite Centre, and has worked for EUROCONTROL, NATO and UNESCO. Within the United Nations justice system, she has provided legal services with the Office of Staff Legal Assistance at the United Nations.

Ms. Chalanouli is a member of the Editorial Advisory Committee of the International Legal Materials. She has written on the institutional aspects of NATO, lawfare, PMSCs, RoEs, on the legal basis of NATO Peace Support Operations; she is a contributing author in *The Handbook of the Law of Visiting Forces* (OUP, Dieter Fleck, ed.).

She was awarded the NATO Meritorious Medal and the Serge Lazareff Prize. She is the recipient of the Madrid Bar's prize for her paper (co-authored), "Legal resilience in hybrid environments".
