



CURRICULUM VITAE

Born in Naples on Feb. 27, 1960, he graduated in law from the University "Federico II" of Naples, discussing a thesis on the law that introduced severance pay into our system, supervisor Prof. Raffaele de Luca Tamajo.

As soon as he graduated, he began practicing as a freelance lawyer, collaborating with the de Luca Tamajo-Boursier Niutta Professional Association, dealing mainly with litigation and consulting in labor, union and social security law. Also within that structure, of which he later became a partner, he created and directed the civil law department, also managing the litigation of some important companies over time.

He was later part of the associated firm Boursier Niutta & Partners, where he is partner in charge of the Naples office.

A member of the Naples Bar, with advocacy at the Superior Magistrates' Courts, since 1994 he has been offering assistance, both judicial and extrajudicial, to national and international clients in labor law and civil law, areas in which he handles litigation and contracts.

In particular, in the civil law sector, in addition to the described litigation activity in favor of important companies, he also carries out consulting activities, particularly in the contractual sector (in matters of agency, individual contracts and/or for the creation of commercial networks in the national territory; in matters of contracting, for the outsourcing of services; in matters of sale or lease of Company; etc.).

He has published on the subject of the nature and effects of the employee's option in the event of dismissal (Massimario di Giurisprudenza del lavoro, 2004, 1-2, 77 e ss.) contributing to the different jurisprudential interpretation gathered, then, in the subsequent legislative intervention.
